

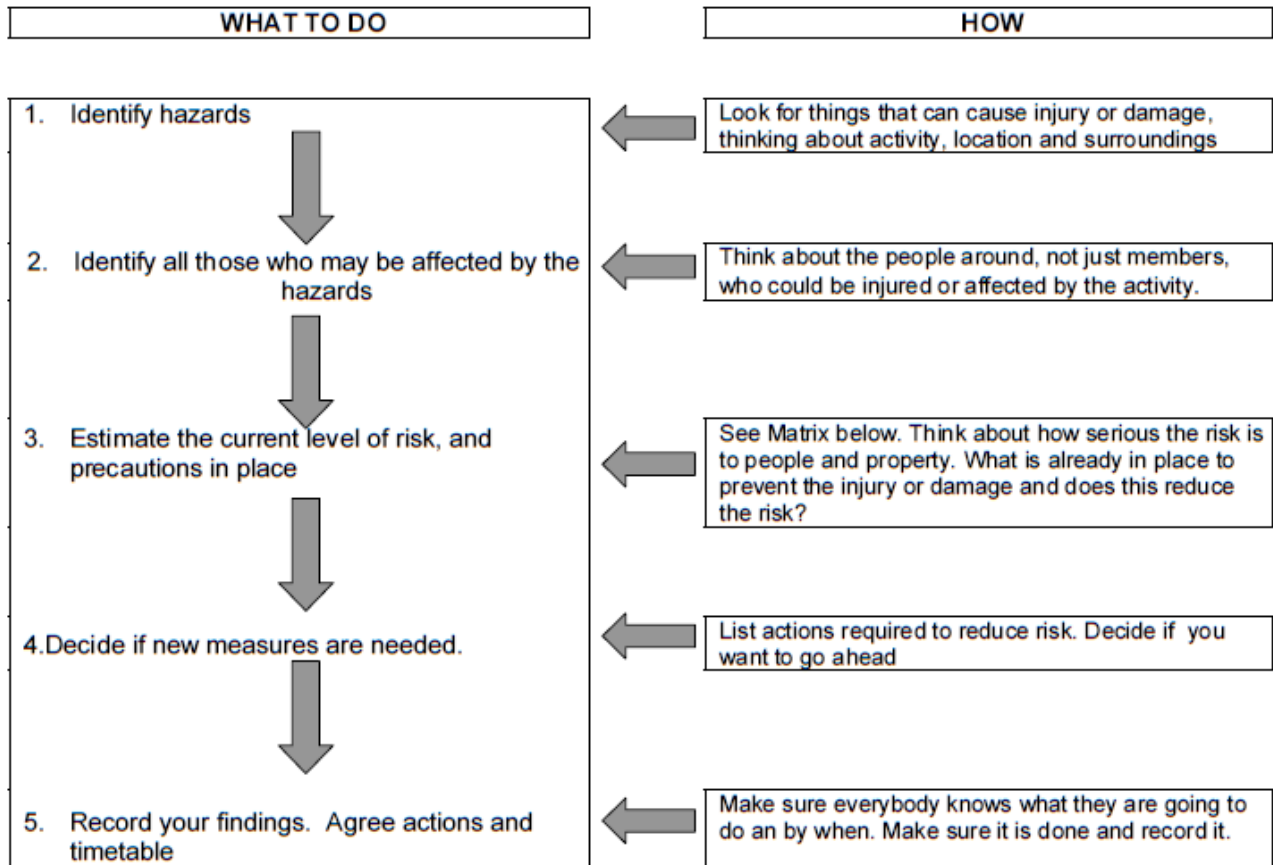

RISK ASSESSMENT MATRIX

	Severity	Slight Harm	Harmful
Likelihood		superficial injuries, minor cuts and bruises	minor fractures, ill health leading to minor disability
UNLIKELY Rarely happens		LOW	LOW
LIKELY Often happens		LOW	MEDIUM
VERY LIKELY Nearly always happens		MEDIUM	HIGH
			Extremely Harmful multiple injuries, major fractures, fatalities
