

## RISK ASSESSMENT MATRIX

Severity	Slight Harm	Harmful	Extremely Harmful
	superficial injuries, minor	minor fractures, ill health	multiple injuries, major
Likelihood	cuts and bruises	leading to minor disability	fractures, fatalities
